ORDER

Jose Cyriac, Chief Secretary (Rtd) as its Chairman. The Members of the Kerala State Innovation Council were not nominated yet. Now Government are pleased to nominate the following officials and eminent persons as Members of the Kerala State Innovation Council subject to the terms and conditions stated below.

The period of the Council shall be for 3 years. The term of the present Chairman shall also be extended to be coterminous with that of the Council.

Members of the KSIInC will function on voluntary basis. However, Kerala State Innovation Council shall meet the expenses such as travel, lodging, local transportation, etc on the same terms as admissible to a Secretary to Government of Kerala. They shall also be admissible to a sitting fee of Rs.5000 per day.

The Kerala State Innovation Council will meet as and when required, but at least once in 3 months. The Chairman, Kerala State Innovation Council may invite any other person considered necessary for discussing specific issues.

For implementing innovations, clusters consisting of 3-4 Members may be set up for each thrust area. The Secretary of the concerned Department, which deals with the sector, will be an ex-officio member of the cluster. Members of each cluster will be experts in the respective thrust areas.
