



I4G DAY 2021 / GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR APPLICANTS

All eligible and interested entities (or “Applicants”) should read the following Terms & Conditions carefully before applying online to participate in I4G DAY 2021 (or “Event”).

1. In favour of a universal approach and to ease logistics of communication, the language of communication throughout the process will be English. All relevant information, including the online application form, is in English. Consequently, each Applicant must be reasonably proficient in English.
2. DATA PROTECTION, PERMISSION TO BE CONTACTED AND CONSENT TO THE USE OF PERSONAL DATA: By submitting an application via the online form for I4G DAY 2021, all Applicants freely permit K-DISC and its authorised representatives to contact them via Email or Call solely in connection with the application for and participation in I4G DAY 2021. For the avoidance of doubt, every Applicant who submits their data for the purpose of participating in this Event shall be deemed to have given express consent for the processing, use, retention or disclosure of such Personal Data for the purposes related to the Event as set out in these General Terms & Conditions.

or Experts for the purposes of evaluating eligibility of and final selection of Applicants for presenting, showcasing and/or demonstrating their products or solutions at the I4G DAY 2021.

The Applicants understand and agree that no information submitted by the Applicants during the online application process for I4G DAY 2021 will be treated by K-DISC as confidential, including without limitation any of the information set forth in Section 7. For the avoidance of doubt, some information submitted by the Entrants may be considered proprietary, such as information that may attract intellectual property rights including without limitation, copyrights, trademarks and patents, any kind of inventions, innovation or novel ideas. However, by entering this Contest, the Applicants expressly waive their right to have this proprietary information kept confidential.

By submitting an application via the online form for I4G DAY 2021, all Applicants warrant and represent that to the best of their knowledge, their submission is original and does not violate or misappropriate any third party trade secret, “know-how,” copyright, patent or other intellectual property right. Applicants also warrant and represent that there are no obligations of any nature, legal or otherwise, which would prohibit, restrict, or interfere with their participation in the event or submission of their Application, and agree to obtain any necessary clearances, authorizations and/or approvals prior to participation.

Applicants hereby grant K-DISC a non-exclusive, worldwide, perpetual, and royalty-free right and license to publish information from their submitted applications, or any portion or modification thereof, in connection with technical or marketing publications, advertisements or promotional activities, including without limitation technical articles by K-DISC, data sheets, application notes, or internet publications.  - e. failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed computer transmissions; (vii) any condition caused by events beyond K-DISC's control that may cause the event to be disrupted or corrupted; and
 - f. any injuries, losses or damages of any kind relating to participation in this event.

K-DISC reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or (temporarily) suspend this Event where required by law or if there is an impediment to the performance of this contract due to a breach by any of K-DISC's contractual partners, or a delay in funding, or a force majeure event, or it becomes technically corrupted or if for any reason the Internet portion of the Event is not capable of running as planned, including infections by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond K-DISC's control, which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this event.
